Child Growth and Development

It has been a difficult year and a half for young children, so maybe now is a good time to check and see if they are developing on target for their age. Our Ages and Stages Help Me Grow program is a free, simple, tool you can use to find out what your child's strengths are and the areas where they may need more practice. Questionnaires are designed specifically for the age of your child, anywhere between birth and 5 ½ years old. Simply complete a Questionnaire in the comfort of your home, then submit it to us for scoring. We'll let you know the results, help you with next steps, if needed, and provide you with fun, simple activities to help with your child's continual growth and development - all for free! Food Assistance

Milton Public Schools' food service is open every Wednesday this summer! This is a drive through food pick-up service for families with children up to age 21. Every Wednesday this summer, from 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM, visit Milton High School and pick up a 10 pound box of fresh produce, 7 breakfasts, 7 lunches, and milk. Enter from Blue Hills Parkway, drive up the hill, take the first left after the front of the building, and drive down the hill to the side of the field. 


