How Many Senses? Featuring a live animal presentation from *Trailside Museum*, you'll learn about a human's five senses and compare them to different animals' senses.

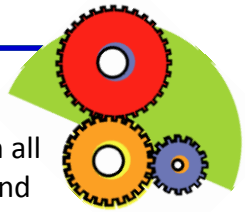
